Changes to SNCT Handbook of Conditions of Service, Paragraph 9.23, periods of notice.

Dear Colleague

The SNCT has agreed the following change to paragraph 9.23.

Existing wording

9.23 The minimum period of notice to terminate employment to be given by a teacher on the main grade scale, a teacher on the Chartered Teacher spine, Music Instructor or an Education Support Officer, Quality Improvement Officer or Education Psychologist shall be 4 working weeks and by all other teachers, quality improvement managers, principal and depute educational psychologists 8 weeks, which include 4 working weeks.

Revised wording

The revised wording now reads as follows:

9.23 The minimum period of notice to terminate employment to be given by a teacher on the main grade scale, a teacher on the Chartered Teacher spine, Lead Teacher, Music Instructor, Education Support Officer, Quality Improvement Officer, Education Psychologist shall be 4 working weeks and by all other teachers, Quality Improvement Managers, Principal and Depute Educational Psychologists 8 weeks, which include 4 working weeks.

The online version of the SNCT Handbook of Conditions of Service will be amended accordingly.
