

#### 1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Scottish Joint Negotiating Committee for Teachers (SJNCT) reached agreement in 2011 on revisions to teachers' terms and conditions which introduced the requirement for Local Negotiating Committees to determine dates of school closure.
- 1.2 The nature of the change is to more clearly define teachers' entitlement to annual leave. Before the change the working year for teachers was 195 days, with the balance of week-days where the school was not open treated as annual leave. This meant that teachers had an annual leave entitlement of 66 days per annum.
- 1.3 The revised position for the 261 days per year (excluding Saturdays and Sundays) is as follows:
  - 190 teaching days
  - 5 In-service or development days
  - 40 days annual leave entitlement
  - Up to 26 days school closure

#### 2. Principles for determining School Closure Dates

- 2.1 Annual leave days should be allocated in a proportionate manner, normally in complete weeks across the four main holiday periods (October 5 days, Christmas 10 days, Easter 10 days, Summer 10 days at the beginning and 5 days at the end) between each school term.
- 2.2 The total number of school closure days can vary from academic year to academic year depending on the setting of the calendar. There can be no less than 190 working days, 5 in-service or development day and 40 annual leave days
- 2.3 SNCT Handbook, Part 2, Section 5 paragraph 5.3 states that public holidays are included in the 40 day annual leave entitlement of a teacher. South Ayrshire Council's JNCT has agreed that some of the public holidays are designated as school closure days.

## 3. Impact of School Closure Days on Annual Salary

3.1 The introduction of school closure days and the revised annual leave accrual rate has no impact on annual salary.

- 3.2 Teachers will continue to work 195 days per annum. With holiday entitlement now set at 40 days per leave year, this provides an annual accrual rate of 0.2051 per working days. (195 working days accruing leave x 0.2051 per day = 40 days).
- 4. Agreed Closure Dates for 2025/2026
- 4.1 The leave year shall run in conjunction with the academic session and the breakdown of how school closure dates have been established is attached as Appendix A and summarised below:

4.2 South Ayrshire Joint Negotiating Committee for Teachers will set future school closure dates no later than May of each academic year and these will be notified to schools prior to the commencement of each school year.
